

ADDITIONAL TERMS FOR ZINC-CONTAINING RAW MATERIALS

Edition January 2002

Specification of Material:

According to usages and classifications of metal trade (UKM / version 1988)

A cadmium content of more than 300 g/t is not allowed.

Radioactivity Clause: Irrespective of all contrary clauses, which set aside or restrict the responsibility of the seller, **he guarantees** that secondary materials, which are concerned by the sale, **are free from any nuclear contaminations and free from any ionizing radiation, which exceeds the natural proper radiation of the secondary materials.** The materials, which do not correspond to this guarantee, must be taken back by the seller at his own cost.

Moreover, the seller is liable to the buyer and will compensate him for any damages caused by **radioactive contaminated** secondary materials, especially disposal cost.

Weighing, Sampling and Analysis:

The weights and analyses determined at the receiving smelter will be decisive for settlement. After the sampling operations are concluded the receiving works are entitled to process the goods immediately.

Crushing Costs:

Should a crushing of the material be necessary, we will charge you with EURO 40,--/t.

We point out that the material, if necessary, has to be marked according to the regulations of determination of residual material (KrW-/AbfG) and that the transport has to be effected according to GGVS/ADR.
