## Temporary shutdown of Waelz oxide production at Harz-Metall GmbH's Goslar plant in Germany

Harz-Metall GmbH, a subsidiary of Recylex GmbH, today announced its decision to temporarily shut down the production of Waelz oxides (zinc) from recycling steel plant dust. This measure has been taken as a result of general market trends, with a decrease in steel plant production and partial or full shutdowns by major clients generating a decline in volumes processed and a contraction in demand.

The production of Waelz oxides of Harz-Metall GmbH represented approximately 4% of Recylex Group's sales as at December 31, 2007 and decreased to approximately 3% of the Group's sales as at June 30, 2008.

This decision forms part of a forward-looking, sound economical and industrial approach.
